7	Part 3 of Article 1 of Chapter 18 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated
8	relating to licenses for funeral directors and embalmers, is amended by revising Code Section
9	43-18-42, relating to reciprocity for licensed embalmers and funeral directors from other
10	states, as follows:
11	"43-18-42.
12	(a) The board may, in its discretion and in accordance with regulations adopted by the
13	board, grant to any person licensed in another state, territory, country, or District o
14	Columbia full privileges to engage in equivalent practice authorized by this article withou
15	taking a national examination if:
16	(1)(A) On or after January 1, 1991, such person successfully passes a written
17	examination approved by the board which tests knowledge of the law of this state
18	relating to funeral directors; and
19	(2)(B) Such person satisfied in another state, territory, country, or District of Columbia
20	the requirements for licensure which are:
21	(A)(i) In effect in Georgia on the date of application; or
22	(B)(ii) Substantially equal to the requirements for a similar license in Georgia: or
23	(2) A person seeking a license pursuant to this Code section has engaged in the active
24	practice of funeral service as a licensed funeral director and embalmer for three years
25	immediately preceding his or her application for a license in Georgia.

1	(b) The approval or denial of a license by endorsement pursuant to this Code section shall
2	be in the sole discretion of the board, and a denial thereof shall not be considered to be a
3	contested case within the meaning of Chapter 13 of Title 50, the 'Georgia Administrative
4	Procedure Act.' Any applicant denied license pursuant to this Code section may request
5	to appear before the board.
6	(c) Nothing in this Code section shall be construed to prevent an applicant denied pursuant
7	to this Code section from taking the examination for licensure pursuant to this article if that
8	applicant otherwise meets the qualifications set out in Code Section 43-18-41."

10 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
