BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

9 Code Section 47-2-99 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the applicability

of creditable service in the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia for persons employed

- in a temporary full-time position, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 12 "(a) Any member of the retirement system, including a member subject to the provisions
- of Code Section 47-2-334, who was, at any time prior to becoming a member, employed
- by an employer as a temporary full-time employee, may obtain up to 12 months of
- 15 creditable service for such service as a temporary full-time employee under the conditions
- 16 contained in this Code section; provided, however, that no such credit shall be granted for
- any period which was covered under Chapter 22 of this title, relating to the Georgia
- 18 Defined Contribution Plan."
- 19 SECTION 2.
- 20 Said Code section is further amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:
- 21 "(c)(1) Any member of the retirement system who was, immediately prior to becoming
- 22 <u>a member, employed in a position in which he or she was covered under Chapter 22 of</u>
- 23 <u>this title, relating to the Georgia Defined Contribution Plan, may obtain creditable service</u>
- 24 <u>for his or her total prior service as a participant in such plan under the conditions</u>
- 25 <u>contained in this Code section.</u>

1 (2) One month of creditable service shall be granted for each 160 hours of credited

- 2 service, not to exceed 12 months of creditable service for all service rendered during any
- 3 <u>single calendar year.</u>
- 4 (3) A member wishing to obtain such creditable service shall pay to the board of trustees
- 5 such amount as determined by the actuary as necessary to grant such benefit without
- 6 <u>creating any actuarial accrued liability as to this retirement system.</u>
- 7 (4) The board of trustees shall require such proof of service as may be necessary to carry
- 8 <u>out the provisions of this Code section.</u>
- 9 (5) In order to obtain creditable service under this Code section, a member must make
- application to the board of trustees not later than December 31, 2008, or within six
- months of becoming a member of this retirement system, whichever date is later.
- 12 (c)(d) Application for creditable service authorized by subsection (a) of this Code section
- must be received by the board of trustees not later than June 30, 2001 <u>December 31, 2008</u>,
- or 24 months after the member becomes a member of the retirement system, whichever
- date is later."

SECTION 3.

- 17 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2008, only if it is determined to have been
- 18 concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 19 Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not
- 20 become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2008, as
- 21 required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.

SECTION 4.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
