## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the 2006-2007 Pro Cheer Junior Coed and Senior All-Girl teams and inviting  
2 them to appear before the House of Representatives; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the 2006-2007 Pro Cheer competition teams have finished another phenomenal  
4 season, culminating in their capture of the Junior Coed and Senior All-Girl Grand  
5 Championship titles at the World Spirit Federation National Championship in Atlanta,  
6 Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, these outstanding young athletes have demonstrated considerable talent,  
8 discipline, coordination, and teamwork throughout the season, and their cheerleading  
9 routines and formations reflect their creativity, spirit, and athleticism; and

10 WHEREAS, the squad's performance is indicative of the extensive training, direction, and  
11 support these cheerleaders have received from their coaches and parents; and

12 WHEREAS, Pro Cheer, Georgia's first cheerleading training center, was founded by Tommy  
13 Martin in 1992 and has won over 51 National Championships; and

14 WHEREAS, Pro Cheer has trained and placed over 100 cheerleaders onto the university  
15 cheerleading squads of such schools as the University of Georgia, Clemson University, the  
16 University of Alabama, the University of Tennessee, Columbus State University, and the  
17 University of West Georgia; and

18 WHEREAS, Pro Cheer has cultivated a positive learning environment where team members  
19 learn to successfully navigate a highly competitive atmosphere while still having fun.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
21 the members of this body commend the 2006-2007 Pro Cheer Junior Coed and Senior
