A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 29A of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to availability and assignment system relating to individual health insurance
- 3 coverage, so as to provide for certain notices to persons who become eligible for COBRA
- 4 coverage or who are receiving COBRA coverage; to provide a definition; to provide for
- 5 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 1 of Chapter 29A of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 availability and assignment system relating to individual health insurance coverage, is
- amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 11 "33-29A-9.
- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'COBRA' means the federal Consolidated
- Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1986.
- 14 (b) All insurers or other persons licensed by the Commissioner who serve as
- administrators in Georgia under employer sponsored, self-funded health benefit
- arrangements or plans or self-funded Taft Hartley plans shall provide notices for all citizens
- of this state regarding potential eligibility for coverage under the Georgia Health Insurance
- Assignment System pursuant to Code Section 33-29A-4 and the Georgia Health Benefits
- 19 Assignment System pursuant to Code Section 33-29A-5. Such notices shall be issued by
- all such insurers, administrators, and other persons to potentially eligible individuals upon
- individuals' fourteenth month of their 18 months of active COBRA coverage. The notice

such individuals' becoming eligible for COBRA coverage and at the beginning of such

- shall be in a form as promulgated under the rules and regulations of the Commissioner and
- shall be mailed by first class mail to such individuals by such insurers, administrators, and
- 25 other persons."
