

## House Resolution 554

## A RESOLUTION

1 Celebrating the life of Willie Howard McBride; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Willie Howard McBride, born December 8, 1925, in the small town of Camilla,  
3 Georgia, was the youngest child of the late Emanuel and Artie Belle McBride; and

4 WHEREAS, he was born into a Christian home, and during his early childhood, he attended  
5 the Church of God in Christ and Union Baptist Church of Camilla, which he later joined; and

6 WHEREAS, from elementary through high school he was an honor roll student, graduating  
7 valedictorian of his class, and after finishing high school, he attended N.Y.A. School in  
8 Jesup, Georgia, completing a course that qualified him as a certified machinist with a  
9 guaranteed deferment against the draft; however, he opted to attend college in September and  
10 was drafted into the navy in February of the following year; and

11 WHEREAS, during his navy career, he was stationed on the troop transport ship, USS  
12 *General S.D. Sturgis*, which was the third ship to dock at Yokohama, Japan, three days  
13 before the treaty of surrender was signed; and

14 WHEREAS, Willie returned to Savannah State College in 1946, graduating with a B.S. in  
15 Social Science in 1949, and he later he earned an M.A. in Education Administration; and

16 WHEREAS, he served 38 years in the Georgia Public School System in a variety of  
17 positions; and

18 WHEREAS, he served as president of the Georgia Council of Mathematics Teachers of  
19 Georgia Teachers Education Association (GTEA) Region 10; director of GTEA; local unit  
20 president, Clarke County Unit of GTEA; mathematics consultant for the Georgia State  
21 Department of Education; was named Teacher of the Year; and was a consultant on eight  
22 Southern Association evaluations of elementary, middle, junior, and high schools; and

1 WHEREAS, he was a member of the Breakfast Optimist Club of Athens; lifetime member  
2 of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Athens Alumni Chapter; lifetime member of Phi Delta Kappa  
3 Fraternity, University of Georgia Chapter; member of the Men's Civic Club of Athens;  
4 president of Savannah State College Alumni Chapter (local and national); member of the  
5 Atlanta University Alumni Chapter (local and national); lifetime member of the Georgia  
6 Retired Educators Association; lifetime member of the NAACP; past president and current  
7 parliamentarian of Athens Area Retired Educators; leadership training officer, Northeast  
8 Council Boy Scouts of America; and sports referee (30 years) for G.H.S.A and G.I.A.; and

9 WHEREAS, one of his greatest pleasures was working as a member of Ebenezer Baptist  
10 Church, West, where he served on the Trustee Board, as chairman of the Board of Deacons,  
11 and in many other capacities; and

12 WHEREAS, he leaves to cherish his memory a loving and devoted wife of 53 years, Frances  
13 Eberhardt McBride; a son, Reginald V. McBride; a daughter-in-law, Dr. Donna McBride of  
14 Stockbridge, Georgia; two grandchildren, Reginald McBride II and Adonna McBride; two  
15 sisters-in-law, Rosa Lee Childs of Columbus, Georgia, and Matilda Simpson of Atlantic City,  
16 New Jersey; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
18 the members of this body celebrate the life well lived of Willie Howard McBride and offer  
19 their condolences to his family and friends upon his passing.
