A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 48-5-18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
2	time for making tax returns, so as to provide that the General Assembly may, by local law,
3	establish a time for making tax returns different from the time provided by general law; to
4	provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
6	SECTION 1.
7	Code Section 48-5-18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the time for
8	making tax returns, is amended by revising subsections (a) and (b) as follows:
9	"(a) Except as otherwise provided in this Code section, each tax commissioner and tax

- 10 receiver shall open his <u>or her</u> books for the return of taxes on January 1 and shall close his
- 11 <u>or her</u> books on April 1 of each year.
- 12 (b) Reserved. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code section, the General
- 13 Assembly may by local law provide that the person authorized to receive tax returns shall
- 14 <u>open his or her books for the return of taxes on January 1 and shall close his or her books</u>
- 15 <u>on March 1 of each year.</u>"
- 16 SECTION 2.
 17 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 18 without such approval.

SECTION 3.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
