- 13 to 1976, and he was the county coroner for 24 years and the state mortician at Reidsville

- 16 Governor of Kiwanis, a commander of the Candler County American Legion, a chairman of
- 17 the Candler County American Red Cross, and a chairman of the Candler County American
- 18 Cancer Society, and he served as a member of the board of directors of the Pineland State
- 19 Bank, the Candler County Hospital Authority, the Metter Housing Authority, the Candler
- 20 County Board of Education, and the Candler County Historical Society; and
- 21 WHEREAS, he served on the State Democratic Executive Committee and as a delegate to
