## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 5 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to inter vivos gifts, so as to change the minimum age for the donation of
- 3 blood from 17 to 16 years of age; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date;
- 4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 5 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 8 relating to inter vivos gifts, is amended by revising Code Section 44-5-89, relating to
- 9 donation of blood by persons over 17 years of age, as follows:
- 10 "44-5-89.

- Any person who is a resident of this state and who is 17 16 years of age or over older may
- donate his <u>or her</u> blood to any person, firm, association, organization, public or private
- agency, or corporation without the consent of his <u>or her</u> parent or parents or guardian. Any
- person who is not a resident of this state and who is 17 16 years of age or over older may
- donate his <u>or her</u> blood to any person, firm, association, organization, public or private
- agency, or corporation in this state without the consent of his <u>or her</u> parent or parents or
- guardian when the laws of the state wherein such person resides permit the donation of
- 18 blood at such age."
- 19 SECTION 2.
- 20 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 21 without such approval.
- SECTION 3.
- 23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
