# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Title 14 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to corporations, 2 partnerships, and associations, so as to provide for the Secretary of State to collect a filing fee for certificates of conversion filed when a Georgia corporation, Georgia limited 3 4 partnership, or Georgia limited liability company converts to a foreign corporation, foreign limited partnership, or foreign limited liability company, respectively; to provide that a 5 certificate of conversion be filed with the Secretary of State to evidence a conversion; to 6 7 allow a copy of a certificate of conversion be filed with the clerk of the superior court in any 8 county in which a converting entity owns property; to provide for related matters; to repeal 9 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

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#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

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#### **SECTION 1.**

12 Title 14 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to corporations, partnerships,

13 and associations, is amended by revising Code Section 14-2-122, relating to filing fees and 14 penalties, as follows:

16 The Secretary of State shall collect the following fees and penalties when the documents described in this Code section are delivered to him or her for filing: 17

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#### **SECTION 2.**

Said title is further amended by revising Code Section 14-2-1109.3, relating to conversion
to foreign limited liability company, foreign limited partnership, or foreign corporation, by
adding a new subsections to read as follows:

- "(i) After a plan of conversion is approved by the shareholders, the corporation shall
  deliver to the Secretary of State for filing a certificate of conversion setting forth:
- 12 (1) The name of the corporation;
- 13 (2) The name and jurisdiction of the entity to which the corporation shall be converted;
- 14 (3) The effective date, or the effective date and time, of such conversion if later than the15 date and time the certificate of conversion is filed;
- (4) A statement that the plan of conversion has been adopted as required by subsection(c) of this Code section;
- (5) A statement that the authority of its registered agent to accept service on its behalf
  is revoked as of the effective time of such conversion and that the Secretary of State is
  irrevocably appointed as the agent for service of process on the resulting entity in any
  proceeding to enforce an obligation of the corporation arising prior to the effective time
  of such conversion;
- (6) A mailing address to which a copy of any process served on the Secretary of State
  under paragraph (5) of this subsection may be mailed as provided in subsection (j) of this
  Code section; and
- 26 (7) A statement that the Secretary of State shall be notified of any change in the resulting
  27 entity's mailing address.

(j) Upon the conversion's taking effect, the resulting entity is deemed to appoint the
Secretary of State as its agent for service of process in a proceeding to enforce any of its
obligations arising prior to the effective time of such conversion. Any party that serves
process upon the Secretary of State in accordance with this subsection also shall mail a
copy of the process to the chief executive officer, chief financial officer, or the secretary
of the resulting entity, or a person holding a comparable position, at the mailing address
provided in subsection (i) of this Code section.

1 (k) A converting corporation pursuant to this Code section may file a copy of its certificate 2 of conversion, certified by the Secretary of State, in the office of the clerk of the superior 3 court of the county where any real property owned by such corporation is located and 4 record such certified copy of the certificate of conversion in the books kept by such clerk 5 for recordation of deeds in such county with the corporation indexed as the grantor and the 6 foreign entity indexed as the grantee. No real estate transfer tax otherwise required by 7 Code Section 48-6-1 shall be due with respect to recordation of such certificate of 8 conversion."

9 SECTION 3.
10 Said title is further amended by revising Code Section 14-9-206.8, relating to conversion to
11 foreign limited liability company, foreign limited partnership, or foreign corporation, by
12 adding a new subsections to read as follows:

13 "(g) After a plan of conversion is approved by the partners, the limited partnership shall
14 deliver to the Secretary of State for filing a certificate of conversion setting forth:

- 15 (1) The name of the limited partnership;
- 16 (2) The name and jurisdiction of the entity to which the limited partnership shall be17 converted;

(3) The effective date, or the effective date and time, of such conversion if later than thedate and time the certificate of conversion is filed;

20 (4) A statement that the plan of conversion has been approved as required by subsection21 (c) of this Code section;

(5) A statement that the authority of its registered agent to accept service on its behalf
is revoked as of the effective time of such conversion and that the Secretary of State is
irrevocably appointed as the agent for service of process on the resulting entity in any
proceeding to enforce an obligation of the limited partnership arising prior to the effective
time of such conversion;

(6) A mailing address to which a copy of any process served on the Secretary of State
under paragraph (5) of this subsection may be mailed as provided in subection (h) of this
Code section; and

30 (7) A statement that the Secretary of State shall be notified of any change in the resulting
31 entity's mailing address.

(h) Upon the conversion's taking effect, the resulting entity is deemed to appoint the
Secretary of State as its agent for service of process in a proceeding to enforce any of its
obligations arising prior to the effective time of such conversion. Any party that serves
process upon the Secretary of State in accordance with this subsection also shall mail a
copy of the process to the chief executive officer, chief financial officer, or the secretary

of the resulting entity, or a person holding a comparable position, at the mailing address 1 2 provided in subsection (g) of this Code section. 3 (i) A converting limited partnership pursuant to this Code section may file a copy of its certificate of conversion, certified by the Secretary of State, in the office of the clerk of the 4 5 superior court of the county where any real property owned by such limited partnership is located and record such certified copy of the certificate of conversion in the books kept by 6 such clerk for recordation of deeds in such county with the limited partnership indexed as 7 8 the grantor and the foreign entity indexed as the grantee. No real estate transfer tax 9 otherwise required by Code Section 48-6-1 shall be due with respect to recordation of such certificate of conversion." 10

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#### **SECTION 5.**

Said title is further amended by revising Code Section 14-11-906, relating to election by a
limited liability company to become a foreign limited liability company, a foreign limited
partnership, or a foreign corporation and certificate of authority, so as to add new subsections
to read as follows:

33 "(g) After a plan of conversion is approved by the members, the limited liability company
34 shall deliver to the Secretary of State for filing a certificate of conversion setting forth:

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- (1) The name of the limited liability company;
- 2 (2) The name and jurisdiction of the entity to which the limited liability company shall
  3 be converted;
- 4 (3) The effective date, or the effective date and time, of such conversion if later than the
  5 date and time the certificate of conversion is filed;
- 6 (4) A statement that the plan of conversion has been approved as required by subsection
  7 (c) of this Code section;
- 8 (5) A statement that the authority of its registered agent to accept service on its behalf 9 is revoked as of the effective time of such conversion and that the Secretary of State is 10 irrevocably appointed as the agent for service of process on the resulting entity in any 11 proceeding to enforce an obligation of the limited liability company arising prior to the 12 effective time of such conversion, including the rights, if any, of dissenting members;
- (6) A mailing address to which a copy of any process served on the Secretary of State
  under paragraph (5) of this subsection may be mailed; and
- (7) A statement that the Secretary of State shall be notified of any change in the resultingentity's mailing address.
- 17 (h) Upon the conversion's taking effect, the resulting entity is deemed:
- (1) To appoint the Secretary of State as its agent for service of process in a proceeding
   to enforce any of its obligations arising prior to the effective time of such conversion,
   including the rights, if any, of dissenting members; and
- (2) To agree that it will promptly pay to any dissenting members the amount, if any, towhich such member is entitled under Article 10 of this chapter.
- 23 (i) A converting limited liability company pursuant to this Code section may file a copy of its certificate of conversion, certified by the Secretary of State, in the office of the clerk 24 25 of the superior court of the county where any real property owned by such limited liability 26 company is located and record such certified copy of the certificate of conversion in the books kept by such clerk for recordation of deeds in such county with the limited liability 27 company indexed as the grantor and the foreign entity indexed as the grantee. No real 28 29 estate transfer tax otherwise required by Code Section 48-6-1 shall be due with respect to recordation of such certificate of conversion." 30

Said title is further amended by revising subsection (a) of Code Section 14-11-1101, relating
to filing fees and penalties, as follows:
