- 15 degree at the young age of 17 and was awarded a fellowship at the D.J Sind College for
- 16 standing first in his class; and
- 17 WHEREAS, after completing his Master of Science degree thesis on the scattering of x-rays
- 18 by solids under the Nobel Laureate Dr. C.V. Raman, Dada gave up a career in academics to
- 19 follow in the footsteps of his illustrious uncle and guru, Sadhu T.L Vaswani; and
- WHEREAS, he began to spread the guru's ideas by editing three monthly journals, one of
- 21 which, *The Excelsior*, became so popular that its circulation surpassed that of the daily
- 22 newspaper, *The Sind Observer*; and
