A RESOLUTION

- 1 Congratulating Piedmont Mountainside Hospital and its president and CEO, Ed Lovern, on
- 2 being named "Hospital of the Year" and "Hospital CEO of the Year" for 2006 by the Georgia
- 3 Alliance of Community Hospitals; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, Piedmont Mountainside Hospital is a 35 bed hospital located in Jasper, Georgia,
- 5 that serves patients in Pickens and several other counties in the foothills of the Appalachian
- 6 Mountains; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the facility is a member of Piedmont Healthcare, a nonprofit organization that
- 8 serves as the parent company for Piedmont Hospital in Atlanta, Piedmont Fayette Hospital
- 9 of Fayetteville, the Piedmont Physicians Group, the Piedmont Hospital Foundation, and the
- 10 Piedmont Clinic; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in two short years, the hospital has made significant progress toward its goal
- of becoming one of the best small hospitals in the country; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Piedmont Mountainside Hospital was named among the nation's 25 Most
- 14 Improved in the 2006 Hospitals & Health Networks' Most Wired survey; and
- 15 WHEREAS, in the past two years, the hospital increased its staff from 264 to 339 employees,
- 16 added more than 65 physicians to its medical staff, and increased overall physician
- 17 satisfaction from 77 percent in 2004 to 93 percent in 2005 and overall employee satisfaction
- 18 from 17 percent to 98 percent; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the facility increased its number of infant deliveries from 171 in 2004 to 274
- 20 in 2006 and increased its number of surgeries from 1,450 to more than 1,900; and

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1 WHEREAS, the hospital has implemented a series of community education programs,

- 2 including its successful "Dessert and Discussion with the Doctor" which attracts more than
- 3 130 people each month; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the hospital has demonstrated a vision for a true community hospital and has
- 5 shared that vision with staff and physicians, leading to the creation of a community medical
- 6 clinic that was founded by volunteers to provide primary care to uninsured county residents;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, Piedmont Healthcare provides outstanding health care services with the highest
- 9 caliber of professionalism, including cardiovascular care, women's services, oncology,
- 10 orthopedics, neuroscience, and kidney, pancreas, and liver transplantation, using state of the
- 11 art technology; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Piedmont Mountainside Hospital's economic contribution is approximately \$65
- 13 million annually; and
- 14 WHEREAS, in October, 2006, the Georgia Alliance of Community Hospitals named the
- 15 facility "Hospital of the Year" and recognized its president and chief executive officer, Ed
- 16 Lovern, as "Hospital CEO of the Year."
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 18 the members of this body congratulate Piedmont Mountainside Hospital and its president and
- 19 CEO, Ed Lovern, for being named "Hospital of the Year" and "Hospital CEO of the Year"
- 20 for 2006 and recognize their many contributions to the health care of Georgia's residents.
