A RESOLUTION

- 1 Congratulating Coach Dave Hunter on the occasion of his retirement; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Dave Hunter was born in Corbin, Kentucky, on October 11, 1944; and
- 3 WHEREAS, he graduated from Fulton High School in 1962 and from the University of
4 Tennessee with a Bachelor of Science degree in 1966 and a Master of Science degree in
5 1972; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Coach Hunter's record as head football coach of Brookwood High School in
7 Snellville, Georgia, was 149-35 in 15 years; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he led the Brookwood Broncos to the 1996 AAAA state football championship;
9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was named Coach of the Year in his region six times, in the state two times,
11 and in Gwinnett County six times; and
- 12 WHEREAS, after he finished his coaching career, he moved into the position of athletic
13 director at Brookwood and was named Athletic Director of the Year in his region four times,
14 for the AAAA classification two times, and All Class Athletic Director of the Year in 1991;
15 and
- 16 WHEREAS, among many other honors, he was named Sportsman of the Decade for
17 Gwinnett County by the Atlanta Journal Constitution; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Coach Hunter has served in many positions during his professional career,
19 including: executive director of the Gwinnett Touchdown Club, executive director of the
20 Corky Kell Kickoff Classic, and member of the advisory board for Habitat for Humanity in
21 Gwinnett County; and

1 WHEREAS, over the past 15 years, Dave Hunter has raised over \$3 million for the benefit
2 of the athletes in all sports at Brookwood High School; and

3 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that Coach Hunter be congratulated on his
4 retirement as the athletic director of Brookwood High School.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
6 the members of this body congratulate Coach Dave Hunter on his accomplishments during
7 his outstanding career and wish him many happy years in a well-deserved retirement.
