The House Committee on Rules offers the following substitute to SB 17:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 2 optometrists, so as to provide for additional pharmaceutical agents which may be used by a

- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6	SECTION 1.
7	Chapter 30 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to optometrists,
8	is amended by revising subparagraph (D) of paragraph (2) of Code Section 43-30-1, relating
9	to definitions, as follows:
10	"(D) Pharmaceutical agents which are used by a doctor of optometry for treatment
11	purposes and administered orally may only be:
12	(i)(I) Nonnarcotic oral analgesics and Schedule III or Schedule IV controlled
13	substances which are oral analgesics;
14	(ii)(III) Used for ocular pain; and
15	(iii)(III) Used for no more than 72 hours without consultation with the patient's
16	physician <u>; or</u>
17	(ii) Oral and topical pharmaceutical agents related to the diagnosis or treatment of
18	diseases and conditions of the eye and adnexa oculi except Schedule I or Schedule II
19	controlled substances; provided, however, that oral steroids shall be limited to a
20	maximum seven-day dose pack. Doctors of optometry using such oral and topical
21	pharmaceutical agents shall be held to the same standard of care imposed by Code
22	Section 51-1-27 as would be applied to a physician licensed under Chapter 34 of this
23	title performing similar acts."

24 SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
