A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the original July Foxhound and recognizing the historical marker to be placed in
- 2 his memory on May 5, 2007, in Hancock County, Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, in July of 1858, two Irish foxhounds arrived for the first time in Georgia as a
- 4 gift to Colonel Miles G. Harris of Hancock County from a noted Maryland hunter, Nimrod
- 5 Gosnell; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Colonel Harris invited hunters from miles around to join him on a fox hunt
- 7 during October of 1859, and the hunters who came from all over middle Georgia were
- 8 extremely skeptical that this unusual hound with short ears and woolly hair could match their
- 9 choice breeds; and
- 10 WHEREAS, none of the dogs that had gone before had been able to catch the quick red fox,
- but on the first hunt the Colonel's new hounds had run down a red fox in less than an hour,
- 12 leaving all the other dogs scattered in their path; and
- WHEREAS, the choicest runners could not match the superior performance of the Irish
- 14 foxhounds in the hunting field chasing red foxes; and
- 15 WHEREAS, regrettably, one of the Irish foxhounds died shortly after the first run, but the
- 16 remaining hound that the Colonel had named "July" survived; and
- 17 WHEREAS, July was made available as a stud in Hancock and Putnam counties, and his
- 18 descendants came to be recognized as July Hounds, one of the best lines of foxhounds
- 19 available in middle Georgia; and
- 20 WHEREAS, in his honor an official historical marker will be erected on Highway 16 in
- 21 Hancock County by the lovers of July Hounds so that all will know the story of the original
- 22 July Foxhound.
