## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To create a board of elections and registration for Greene County and to provide for its

- 2 powers and duties; to provide for definitions; to provide for the composition of the board and
- 3 the selection and appointment of members; to provide for the qualification, terms, and
- 4 removal of members; to provide for oaths and privileges; to provide for meetings,
- 5 procedures, and vacancies; to relieve certain officers of powers and duties and to provide for
- 6 the transfer of functions to the newly created board; to provide for certain expenditures of
- 7 public funds; to provide for compensation of members of the board and personnel; to provide
- 8 for offices and equipment; to provide for the board's performance of certain functions and
- 9 duties for certain municipalities; to provide for related matters; to provide for submission for
- 10 preclearance under Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to
- 11 provide effective dates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

13 SECTION 1.

- 14 Pursuant to subsection (b) of Code Section 21-2-40 of the O.C.G.A., there is created the
- 15 Board of Elections and Registration of Greene County, hereinafter referred to as "the board."
- 16 The board shall have the powers, duties, and responsibilities of the judge of the probate court
- 17 of Greene County under Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code,"
- and the powers, duties, and responsibilities of the board of registrars of Greene County
- 19 under Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code."

20 SECTION 2.

- 21 The terms "election," "elector," "political party," "primary," and "public office" shall have
- 22 the same meaning as set forth in Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election
- 23 Code," unless otherwise clearly apparent from the text of this Act, and the term
- 24 "commissioners" means the Board of Commissioners of Greene County and "county" means
- 25 Greene County.

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SECTION 3.

2 (a) The board shall be composed of three members who shall be appointed as provided in

- 3 this section.
- 4 (b) One member of the board shall be appointed by the county executive committee of the
- 5 political party which received the highest number of votes within the county for its candidate
- 6 for Governor in the general election immediately preceding the appointment of such member.
- 7 One member of the board shall be appointed by the county executive committee of the
- 8 political party which received the second highest number of votes within the county for its
- 9 candidate for Governor in the general election immediately preceding the appointment of
- such member. In the event that there is no county executive committee of a political party
- 11 entitled to make an appointment under this subsection, the appointment on behalf of such
- 12 political party shall be made by the state executive committee of such party.
- 13 (c) One member of the board shall be selected by the governing authority of Greene County.
- 14 (d) All appointments to the board shall be promptly certified by the appointing authority of
- 15 Greene County to the clerk of the Superior Court of Greene County.
- 16 (e) The initial appointees to the board shall take office on July 1, 2007. Each initial member
- shall serve a term of office beginning on July 1, 2007, and ending on December 31, 2010,
- and until his or her respective successor is duly appointed and qualified. Successors to each
- such member shall thereafter be appointed by the appropriate appointing authority to serve
- 20 a term of office of four years beginning January 1, 2011, and until his or her respective
- 21 successor is duly appointed and qualified. Thereafter, all members shall be appointed to
- 22 serve four-year terms of office.
- 23 (f) The member of the board appointed by the county governing authority shall serve as
- 24 chairperson of the board. Such chairperson shall preside over all meetings of the board and
- shall be entitled to vote on all matters coming before the board.

SECTION 4.

- 27 There shall be an election supervisor who shall generally direct and control the
- 28 administration of the affairs of the board pursuant to law and duly adopted resolutions of the
- 29 board. The election supervisor shall not be a member of the board. The appointment of the
- 30 supervisor shall be made by the board of commissioners, which will consider the
- 31 recommendation of the board of elections and registration. The supervisor shall be appointed
- 32 and removed by the board of commissioners in the same manner as department heads. The
- 33 compensation of such election supervisor shall be established by the board of commissioners
- 34 in the same manner as department heads. The election supervisor shall provide daily
- 35 employee supervision, serve as staff support for the board, attend all meetings of the board,

1 carry out the duties of voter registration and elections as required by law, and be a full-time

2 employee of Greene County.

3 SECTION 5.

- 4 Each member of the board shall:
- 5 (1) Be eligible to be reappointed to succeed such member;
- 6 (2) Have the right to resign at any time by giving written notice of such resignation to
- 7 the governing authority of Greene County and to the clerk of the superior court; and
- 8 (3) Serve until his or her successor is appointed and qualified.

9 SECTION 6.

- 10 (a) The appointing authority shall certify the appointment of each member of the board by
- filing an affidavit with the clerk of the superior court no later than 30 days preceding the date
- 12 upon which such members are to take office, stating the name and residential address of the
- person appointed and certifying such member has been duly appointed as provided in this
- 14 Act.
- 15 (b) The clerk of the superior court shall record each of such certifications on the minutes of
- 16 the superior court and shall certify the name of each such appointed member to the Secretary
- 17 of State and provide for the issuance of appropriate commissions to the members within the
- same time and in the same manner as provided by law for registrars.

19 **SECTION 7.** 

- 20 In the event a vacancy occurs in the office of any member before the expiration of his or her
- 21 term, by removal, death, resignation, or otherwise, the appointing authority which is required
- 22 under Section 3 of this Act to make the appointment to the office upon the expiration of the
- 23 term shall appoint a successor to serve the remainder of the unexpired term as provided for
- 24 in Section 3 of this Act. If the vacancy in office is not filled within 60 days after it occurs,
- 25 the vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of the term by the governing authority of Greene
- 26 County. The clerk of the superior court shall be notified of such interim appointments and
- 27 record and certify such appointments in the same manner as the regular appointment of
- 28 members.
- SECTION 8.
- 30 (a) The first members of the board under this Act shall be appointed as provided in this Act
- 31 to take office on July 1, 2007. The board shall take no official action until all members have
- 32 been certified to the clerk of the Superior Court of Greene County.

1 (b) Before entering upon the member's duties, each member shall take substantially the

2 same oath as required by law for registrars and shall have the same privileges from arrest.

3 SECTION 9.

- 4 (a) No person who holds elective public office shall be eligible to serve as a member of the
- 5 board during the term of such elective office, and the position of any member of the board
- 6 shall be deemed vacant upon such member's qualifying as a candidate for elective public
- 7 office.
- 8 (b) Members of the board must be residents of Greene County and must have been registered
- 9 voters in Greene County for a period of at least one year prior to the date of appointment to
- 10 the board.

11 **SECTION 10.** 

- 12 The board shall have the authority to contract with any municipality or governmental
- 13 authority located within Greene County for the holding by the board of any primary or
- 14 election to be conducted within such municipality or governmental authority. The full costs
- 15 of any such election shall be paid for by the requesting municipality or governmental
- authority along with a fee established by the board to offset operational costs of the office
- 17 of the Greene County Board of Elections and Registration.

18 **SECTION 11.** 

- 19 (a) The board shall be authorized and empowered to organize itself, elect from among its
- 20 members a vice chairperson, determine its procedural rules and regulations, adopt bylaws,
- 21 specify the functions and duties of its employees, and otherwise take such action as is
- 22 appropriate to the management of its affairs; provided, however, that no such action shall
- 23 conflict with state law.
- 24 (b) Action and decision by the board shall be by a majority of the members of the board.

25 **SECTION 12.** 

- 26 (a) The board shall fix and establish, by appropriate resolution entered on its minutes,
- 27 directives governing the execution of matters within its jurisdiction. The board shall hold
- 28 meetings at the office of the Greene County Board of Elections and Registration or at the
- 29 place of meeting of the commissioners. Any specially called meetings held pursuant to the
- 30 bylaws adopted by the board shall be held only after notification of the time and place of the
- 31 holding of such special meeting has been communicated in writing to the election supervisor
- 32 to provide public notice of the meeting as required by law. All meetings of whatever kind
- of the board shall be conducted pursuant to Chapter 14 of Title 50 of the O.C.G.A.

1 (b) The board shall maintain a written record of policy decisions amended to include

- 2 additions or deletions. Such written records shall be made available for the public to review
- 3 pursuant to Article 4 of Chapter 18 of Title 50 of the O.C.G.A.

4 SECTION 13.

- 5 Compensation for the members of the board shall be fixed by the Board of Commissioners
- 6 of Greene County. All amounts payable under this section shall be paid from the funds of
- 7 Greene County.

8 SECTION 14.

- 9 (a) The board may employ, subject to funding by the Greene County Board of
- 10 Commissioners, additional clerical assistants as needed to efficiently carry out the duties and
- 11 functions of the board on either an independent contract basis or as county employees
- 12 entitled to all benefits as other county employees, to be determined by the board of
- 13 commissioners. The compensation of all clerical assistants shall be established by the board
- 14 of commissioners in the same manner as for other county employees. Any such assistants
- shall be at-will employees of the board of commissioners.
- 16 (b) The board of commissioners, at their legislative discretion, shall provide suitable offices
- and equipment and funding sufficient to employ the staff and other employees as may be
- 18 necessary.

19 **SECTION 15.** 

20 The board shall be responsible for the selection, appointment, and training of poll workers.

21 **SECTION 16.** 

- 22 The Board of Commissioners of Greene County shall cause, through its legal counsel, this
- 23 Act to be submitted for preclearance under Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of
- 24 1965, as amended, within 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the
- 25 Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.

26 **SECTION 17.** 

- 27 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 28 without such approval for purposes of making initial appointments to the board only. This
- 29 Act shall become fully effective on July 1, 2007. Upon this Act becoming fully effective or
- 30 upon such later date determined by the board of commissioners, the superintendent of
- 31 elections of Greene County and the board of registrars of Greene County shall be relieved
- 32 of all powers and duties to which the board succeeds by the provisions of this Act and shall

1 deliver to the board all equipment, supplies, materials, books, papers, records, and facilities

- 2 pertaining to such powers and duties. Nothing contained herein is intended to prevent the
- 3 appointment of members of the board, the hiring of an election supervisor, the hiring of
- 4 clerical staff, or any necessary training for the members of the board, the election supervisor,

5 and clerical assistants.

## 6 SECTION 18.

7 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
