## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and expressing support for civic education in our public schools; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, our constitutional democracy requires the continued participation of an engaged
- 4 citizenry to function effectively; and
- 5 WHEREAS, it is widely recognized that the civic mission of schools is essential to the
- 6 preparation of future citizens; and
- 7 WHEREAS, representative delegations from Georgia have participated in the Congressional
- 8 Conferences on Civic Education for the past four years and conference delegates have
- 9 affirmed the need for a renewed national and state commitment to civic education; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Georgia Council for the Social Studies has developed a position paper,
- 11 "Teaching and Learning Social Studies in Georgia," that recognizes social studies as a vital
- 12 discipline and of critical importance to the development of citizens with the ability and
- disposition to participate effectively in a democratic society.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, that the members of this body
- 15 endorse the continued participation in and the work of the Congressional Conference on
- 16 Civic Education and the position of teaching and learning social studies in Georgia as
- 17 presented by the Georgia Council for the Social Studies.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized to transmit
- 19 appropriate copies of this resolution to the Georgia delegation to the Congressional
- 20 Conference on Civic Education and the Georgia Council for the Social Studies.
