A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Joshua Samuel Leonard; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Joshua Samuel Leonard has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most
3 distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and Josh
8 has ably demonstrated his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills
9 taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Josh is currently an honor student at University of Georgia; and his Eagle Scout
11 project was to design, build, and install picnic tables for the students at Dean Rusk Middle
12 School, an endeavor that included a considerable amount of landscaping; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in a world which consistently seems to accentuate the negative aspects of the
14 actions of young people, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with
15 particularity the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual.

17 commend Joshua Samuel Leonard for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest
18 honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
