5 WHEREAS, her father, Enzo Ottolenghi, and mother, Claudia Di Castro Ottolenghi, were
6 children during World War II, and both share the experience of escaping the conflict by hiding
7 in convents; and

8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Sanders, whose father recently celebrated 50 years as a member of the
9 Italian courts, earned her law degree at La Sapienza University, Rome, in 1998 and received
10 her Master of Business Administration degree at Georgia State University in 2005; and

11 WHEREAS, she enjoys running and recently completed a half marathon in Atlanta, and she
12 is the loving wife of Alan David Sanders and the proud mother of Danny, Jeremy, and Rose;

14 WHEREAS, naturalization is a long and difficult process for many applicants, and as Mrs.
15 Sanders completed that process and became a citizen of the United States on March 23, 2007,
16 it is fitting and proper that this body congratulate such an accomplished new citizen.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 join in congratulating Mrs. Ghila Sanders on the occasion of her naturalization as a citizen of
19 the United States.
