A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the 25x'25 national campaign for agricultural energy sources; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, American agriculture is poised to play a more important role in meeting our
4 nation's future energy needs; and

5 WHEREAS, increasing America's renewable energy use will bring new technologies to
6 market and save consumers money, reduce our dependence on oil from the Middle East, and
7 create good new jobs in rural America; and

8 WHEREAS, leaders from across every sector of America's agricultural community have
9 established the 25x'25 national campaign with the stated goal of obtaining "25 percent of our
10 energy from renewable resources like wind, solar, and biofuels by the year 2025"; and

11 WHEREAS, the 25x'25 action plan, "Charting America's Energy Future," has been widely
12 acclaimed as a visionary course of action for the nation; and

13 WHEREAS, Georgia leaders recognize the importance of developing a comprehensive
14 alternative energy industry; and

15 WHEREAS, Georgia seeks to lead the nation in research and private sector investment in
