A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

	To amend Code Section 33-6-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	enumeration of unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices, so
3	as to prohibit unscrupulous practices regarding the marketing and sale of insurance; to
4	provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6	SECTION 1.
7	Code Section 33-6-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to enumeration of
8	unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices, is amended by
9	revising paragraph (14) of subsection (b) and adding a new paragraph (14.1) to read as
10	follows:
11	"(14) Failing to disclose in printed advertising material that medical benefits are
12	calculated on the basis of usual, customary, and reasonable charges; or
13	(14.1) Engaging in dishonest, unfair, or deceptive insurance practices in marketing or
14	sales of insurance and, notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the
15	Commissioner may promulgate such rules and regulations as necessary to define
16	dishonest, unfair, or deceptive marketing and sales practices; or"
17	SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. 18

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
