## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Senate Study Committee on Cigarette Tax Evasion; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, there is a growing problem in Georgia with untaxed cigarettes being brought
- 3 into the state; and
- 4 WHEREAS, an infrastructure exists in which counterfeit stamps are being placed on
- 5 legitimate cigarette products; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia is losing tobacco tax revenue because the tax is not being
- 7 paid as required on products being imported into this state; and
- 8 WHEREAS, this loss has increased following the tax increase on cigarettes; and
- 9 WHEREAS, current policy and procedure makes the identification of counterfeit tax stamps
- 10 difficult to spot.
- 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that there is created the Senate
- 12 Study Committee on Cigarette Tax Evasion to be composed of not more than five members.
- 13 The President of the Senate shall appoint not more than five members of the Senate as
- 14 members of the committee and shall designate one of such members as chairperson. The
- 15 chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee.
- 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall undertake a study of the conditions,
- 17 needs, issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any actions
- 18 or legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate. The committee may
- 19 conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- 20 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- 21 accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution. The members of the committee
- shall receive the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of

1 Georgia Annotated. All funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall

- 2 come from funds appropriated to the Senate. The expenses and allowances authorized by
- 3 this resolution shall not be received by any member of the committee for more than five days
- 4 unless additional days are authorized. In the event the committee makes a report of its
- 5 findings and recommendations, with suggestions for proposed legislation, if any, such report
- 6 shall be made on or before December 31, 2007. The committee shall stand abolished on
- 7 January 31, 2008.
