

House Bill 90 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 18 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to funeral directors and establishments, embalmers, and crematories, so as to provide
3 for certain requirements and options for licensing and license holders; to provide additional
4 options for reciprocity; to provide for certain procedures; to provide that a funeral
5 establishment operated by a person and others licensed by the State Board of Funeral
6 Services shall have an adequate stock of funeral caskets on the premises; to provide that the
7 display room may contain actual caskets or may contain models, mock-ups, or sections of
8 caskets or similar items if such caskets are readily available and in stock for purchase at the
9 establishment or can be delivered within 24 hours; to provide for related matters; to repeal
10 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

13 Article 1 of Chapter 18 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
14 funeral directors and establishments, embalmers, and crematories, is amended by revising
15 Code Section 43-18-42, relating to reciprocity for licensed embalmers and funeral directors
16 from other states, as follows:

17 "43-18-42.

18 (a) The board may, in its discretion and in accordance with regulations adopted by the
19 board, grant to any person licensed in another state, territory, country, or District of
20 Columbia full privileges to engage in equivalent practice authorized by this article without
21 taking a national examination if:

22 (1)(A) On or after January 1, 1991, such person successfully passes a written
23 examination approved by the board which tests knowledge of the law of this state
24 relating to funeral directors; and
