## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the airborne forces of the United States Armed Forces and designating August
- 2 16, 2007, as "Airborne Heritage Day"; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the airborne forces of the United States Armed Forces have a long and
- 4 honorable history as units of adventuresome, hardy, and fierce warriors who, for the national
- 5 security of the United States and the defense of freedom and peace, carry the effective
- 6 ground combat power of the United States by Air Force air transport to the far reaches of
- 7 battle areas around the world; and
- 8 WHEREAS, August 16 marks the anniversary of the first official jump by the Army
- 9 Parachute Test Platoon, which officially validated the concept of inserting United States
- 10 ground combat forces behind battle lines by means of a parachute; and
- WHEREAS, the United States' experiment with airborne infantry attack began on June 25,
- 12 1940, when the Army Parachute Test Platoon was first authorized by the United States
- 13 Department of War, and was launched when 48 volunteers began training in July of 1940;
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, the success of the Parachute Test Platoon in the days immediately preceding the
- 16 entry of the United States into World War II led to the formation of a formidable force of
- 17 airborne units that, since then, have served with distinction and repeated success in armed
- 18 hostilities; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the achievements of the airborne forces during World War II provided a basis
- 20 for evolution into a diversified force of parachute and air-assault units that over the years
- 21 have fought in Korea, Vietnam, Granada, Panama, the Persian Gulf Region, and Somalia and
- 22 that have engaged in peacekeeping operations in Lebanon, the Sinai Peninsula, the
- 23 Dominican Republic, Haiti, Bosnia, and Kosovo; and

1 WHEREAS, the members of the United States combat airborne forces, both past and present,

- 2 have earned many awards, such as the Medal of Honor, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
- 3 Silver Star, the airborne's Silver Wings of Courage, and other awards, for displays of heroism
- 4 and valor; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the United States Senate has recognized the significant contributions of the
- 6 airborne community and the many sacrifices of the nation's paratroopers and (in former days)
- 7 glider troops through resolutions proclaiming August 16 as National Airborne Day from
- 8 1999 through 2006; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the history and achievements of the members and former members of the
- 10 airborne forces of the United States Armed Forces warrant the warmest gratitude of the
- 11 American people.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 13 the members of this body do hereby commend the airborne forces of the United States
- 14 Armed Forces for their heroic efforts on behalf of the American people.
- 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in tribute to the history and achievements of the
- airborne forces of the United States Armed Forces, August 16, 2007, is hereby designated
- 17 as "Airborne Heritage Day."
