	SECTION 1.
Chapter 30 d	of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to optometrists,
is amended b	by revising subparagraph (D) of paragraph (2) of Code Section 43-30-1, relating
to definition	as, as follows:
"(D) F	Pharmaceutical agents which are used by a doctor of optometry for treatment
purpos	ses and administered orally may only be:
(i) <u>(</u>	I) Nonnarcotic oral analgesics and Schedule III or Schedule IV controlled
sub	ostances which are oral analgesics;
<del>(ii)</del>	(II) Used for ocular pain; and
<del>(iii)</del>	Used for no more than 72 hours without consultation with the patient's
phy	ysician <u>; or</u>
<u>(ii)</u>	Oral and topical antibiotics, antivirals, topical steroids, antifungals,
<u>antih</u>	istamines, or antiglaucoma agents related to the diagnosis or treatment of
<u>disea</u>	ses and conditions of the eye and adnexa oculi except Schedule I or Schedule II
<u>contr</u>	colled substances. Doctors of optometry using such oral and topical
<u>pharr</u>	maceutical agents shall be held to the same standard of care imposed by Code
<u>Secti</u>	on 51-1-27 as would be applied to a physician licensed under Chapter 34 of this
title p	performing similar acts; provided, however, that a doctor of optometry shall not

be authorized to treat systemic diseases."
