

The House Committee on Judiciary Non-civil offers the following substitute to SB 1:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 2 of Article 3 of Chapter 12 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
2 Annotated, relating to offenses related to minors generally, so as to provide that it shall be
3 unlawful for persons required to register as sexual offenders to photograph a minor under
4 certain circumstances; to provide for penalties; to provide for related matters; to repeal
5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Part 2 of Article 3 of Chapter 12 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
9 relating to offenses related to minors generally, is amended by adding a new Code section
10 to the end of the part to read as follows:

11 "16-12-100.4.

12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:

13 (1) 'Minor' means any individual who is under 18 years of age.

14 (2) 'Photograph' means to take any picture, film or digital photograph, motion picture
15 film, videotape, or similar visual representation or image of a person.

16 (b) It shall be unlawful for any person who is required to register as a sexual offender
17 pursuant to Code Section 42-1-12 to intentionally photograph a minor for indecent
18 purposes.

19 (c) Any person who violates this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of a high
20 and aggravated nature."

21 **SECTION 2.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
