## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act relating to the Board of Education of Colquitt County, approved March 12,
- 2 1970 (Ga. L. 1970, p. 2582), as amended, so as to provide for the election of members of the
- 3 Board of Education of Colquitt County in nonpartisan elections; to provide for applicability;
- 4 to provide for submission of this Act for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act
- 5 of 1965, as amended; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 An Act relating to the Board of Education of Colquitt County, approved March 12, 1970
- 9 (Ga. L. 1970, p. 2582), as amended, is amended by adding a new section to read as follows:
- 10 "Section 2A
- All elections for the Board of Education of Colquitt County conducted after January 1,
- 12 2008, shall be nonpartisan elections as provided for in Code Section 21-2-139 of the
- O.C.G.A. Such nonpartisan elections shall be held in conjunction with the November
- 14 general election immediately preceding the expiration of the term of office and conducted
- as provided in Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the 'Georgia Election Code.'"

SECTION 2.

- 17 Nothing in this Act shall affect the term of office of any member of the Board of Education
- of Colquitt County in office on January 1, 2008. The sitting members shall serve out the
- 19 terms of office for which they were elected and shall be eligible to succeed themselves.
- SECTION 3.
- 21 The Board of Education of Colquitt County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act to
- be submitted for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, no
- 23 later than 60 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the Governor or otherwise
- 24 becomes law without such approval.
