7 the Department of Juvenile Justice in Tifton; and

8 WHEREAS, he was known around town as "the probation officer"; and

9 WHEREAS, he was an active supporter of the Optimist Club and Big Brothers and Big
10 Sisters and he shared his passion for soccer with the community by coaching youth teams for
11 16 years; and

12 WHEREAS, he was fond of "unusual" ties and flamboyant dress; and

13 WHEREAS, he is survived by his loving wife, Linda, and two devoted daughters, Layla and
14 Hallie, as well as other family and friends; and

15 WHEREAS, Michael was a funny, compassionate, intelligent, generous man, who fought for
16 the underdog, and acted as the voice of many who had no voice, and he leaves behind a huge
17 void in the community and he will be sorely missed by all.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 celebrate the life of Michael Cantlebury and offer their sincerest condolences to his family
20 and friends upon his passing along with sincere appreciation for his selfless service to the
