

House Bill 775 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a Board of Commissioners for Hall County, approved March 21,
2 1935 (Ga. L. 1935, p. 661), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 6, 1992
3 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 5327), so as to change the provisions of law concerning the expense
4 allowance received by the chairperson and members of the Board of Commissioners of Hall
5 County; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act creating a Board of Commissioners for Hall County, approved March 21, 1935
9 (Ga. L. 1935, p. 661), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 6, 1992
10 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 5327), is amended by revising subsection (b) of Section 12 as follows:

11 "(b) For each meeting attended by the board which the commissioner attends in his or her
12 official capacity as a member of the board, the chairperson and each member of the board
13 shall be authorized to receive an expense allowance equal to the daily expense allowance
14 provided by law for members of the General Assembly but shall be authorized to receive
15 the same for not more than ten meetings per month; provided, however, that, if, by
16 December 31, 2007, the board by majority vote adopts a resolution to do so, the board may
17 increase the authorization to receive said expense allowance to not more than 12 meetings
18 per month."

19 **SECTION 2.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
