- 2 WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff DeAnna Jarrett of Cherokee County defines the ideal of service
- 3 to the public by law enforcement on or off duty; and
- 4 WHEREAS, on March 19, 2007, off-duty Deputy Sheriff Jarrett displayed selfless courage
- 5 and heroism in responding to an automotive accident and preventing a tragedy; and
- 6 WHEREAS, at 9:00 p.m. there occurred an automobile accident on Georgia Highway 515
- 7 across from Piedmont Mountainside Medical Center in Jasper, Georgia; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Jarrett stopped at the wreck site and began to assist by pulling
- 9 one of the drivers from his vehicle when the car suddenly erupted in flames; despite the
- 10 obvious danger to herself, she continued to remove the victim, a United States military
- 11 enlisted man who had suffered a broken leg; and
- 12 WHEREAS, her extraordinary heroism has brought honor to the law enforcement profession.
- 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body hereby
- 14 recognizes and commends Deputy Sheriff DeAnna Jarrett for her outstanding service to the
- 15 State of Georgia and its citizens and expresses its gratitude to her.
