A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 34-4-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the  
2 amount of minimum wage to be paid by employers, so as to raise the minimum wage; to  
3 provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for  
4 other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 34-4-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the amount of  
8 minimum wage to be paid by employers, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:  
9 "(a) Except as otherwise provided in this Code section, every employer, whether a person,  
10 firm, or corporation, shall pay to all covered employees a minimum wage which shall be  
11 not less than ~~\$5.15~~ \$10.00 per hour for each hour worked in the employment of such  
12 employer."

13 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 2.**

14 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2007.

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
