A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Officer Shane Collie of the Woodstock Police Department;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Officer Shane Collie has been named Officer of the Year at the annual awards
4 ceremony sponsored by the Canton Moose Lodge; and

5 WHEREAS, Officer Collie gained distinction by requiring essays for minor offenses in order
6 to divert those who might otherwise have ended up in jail or juvenile detention; and

7 WHEREAS, his collaboration with the Department of Public Works to install delineators for
8 preventing traffic accidents gained the attention of the award committee and his supervisors;

10 WHEREAS, with precision and professionalism, Officer Collie has made 98 arrests and
11 issued over 300 citations since January of 2007; and

12 WHEREAS, Officer Collie has demonstrated the need to be comprehensive in his approach,
13 and he continues to set new standards for others in the department; and

14 WHEREAS, his actions have brought honor to his family, community, the Woodstock Police
15 Department, and the State of Georgia.

17 recognize Officer Shane Collie for his valorous service to the Woodstock Police Department
18 and to the State of Georgia and extend to him their sincerest best wishes for his future health
