11 principles, as demonstrated by his Eagle Scout project; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in a world which consistently seems to accentuate the negative aspects of the
13 actions of young people, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with
14 particularity the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual.

16 commend Malcolm Jackson for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor
17 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious
