5 and distinction as a teacher of emotionally and behaviorally disturbed and learning-disabled
6 students at Mountain Road Elementary School; and

8 inspiration and enthusiasm to her pupils and to create a positive learning environment by
9 connecting with her students; and

10 WHEREAS, in recognition of her outstanding achievements, she has been named 2008
11 Teacher of the Year of the Cherokee County school district; and

13 education professionals are making on the quality of education received by the children of
14 this state, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that her superlative accomplishments be
15 recognized appropriately.
