A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-5-22 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 persons not to be licensed, minimum ages for licenses, school attendance requirements, and
3 driving training requirements, so as to provide that a course of instruction given within the
4 context of a bona fide home schooling program shall constitute an approved driver education
5 training course; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 40-5-22 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to persons not to
9 be licensed, minimum ages for licenses, school attendance requirements, and driving training
10 requirements, is amended by adding a new paragraph at the end of subsection (a.2) to read
11 as follows:

12 "(5) For purposes of this Code section, the term 'approved driver education training course'
13 shall include instruction given in the course of a home education program that satisfies the
14 reporting requirements of all state laws governing such programs, provided that such
15 instruction satisfies all requirements for such courses."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
