- 2 WHEREAS, Bishop Willie James Toney passed away on December 2, 2007, in Indianapolis,  
3 Indiana, after a long and productive life serving the Lord and his fellow men and women; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was born on October 28, 1936, in Selma, Alabama, the son of Oscar Toney,  
5 Sr., and Lucille Fail; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he completed his apprenticeship as a journeyman electrician at Ivy Tech  
7 Community College and retired in May, 2001, 20 years later, from Naval Avionics Center  
8 in Indianapolis; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he was called to the ministry at New Life Community Church of Truth, Inc.,  
10 in 1992, and he used his talents as a minister and vocalist to give glory to the Lord for many  
11 years; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he was ordained bishop in 2005, and he held several positions at New Life,  
13 including co-founder and national bishop; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he is survived by the love of his life, his wife Sylvia, whom he married in 1975,  
15 two daughters, Dannella Toney-Allen and Chasity Jefferson-Toney, seven grandchildren,  
16 five step-children, a brother, four sisters, and a host of other relatives and friends.
