- 1 Recognizing and honoring the life of Charles A. Robinson; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Charles A. Robinson was born on November 5, 1953; and
- 3 WHEREAS, he grew up in Dougherty County, Georgia, and he was a 1971 graduate of
4 Albany High School and a 1981 graduate of Albany State University; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he initially began his career in the entertainment business, becoming a radio
6 disc jockey with a local radio station, where he was affectionately known as, "Big Charles
7 Stone" on WJIZ; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Mr. Robinson eventually decided to leave the radio station to pursue a teaching
9 career, and he became a middle school teacher at Merry Acres Middle School in Dougherty
10 County; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he became a prolific leader in the education arena and an inspirational instructor
12 impacting the lives of the students he taught; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in addition to his career, Mr. Robinson was very active in his community
14 serving in the National Education Association, the Georgia Association of Educators, and as
15 membership chairman in the Dougherty County Association of Educators; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he worked faithfully for his alma mater, Albany State University, and was a
17 lifelong member of Arcadia Baptist Church, where he served in the youth choir and on the
18 usher board; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he was married to Mrs. Chitea Summers-Robinson and enjoyed spending time
20 with friends; and

1 WHEREAS, he felt that his mission in life was to live life to the fullest, to love the Lord, to
2 always give one's best, and to do well to all men, and these things he accomplished with a
3 big smile that will be a constant reminder to all who knew him to have a positive outlook on
4 life.

6 hereby recognize the inspirational life of Charles A. Robinson and extend to his family and
