A RESOLUTION

1 Commending and honoring Linda Williams as the 2007 Georgia Professor of the Year; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, a proper quality education for the young people of this state is the single most
4 important objective of the General Assembly; and

5 WHEREAS, dedication and diligence by committed teachers foster excellence in education;

7 WHEREAS, Linda Williams dreamed about becoming a teacher during her youth and began
8 her career graduating from Southwest DeKalb in 1972; and

9 WHEREAS, graduate school took her to Oklahoma where she earned a master's degree in
10 English at the University of Central Oklahoma in 1986, and a doctorate in higher education
11 administration in 1990; and

12 WHEREAS, she returned to Georgia and began her career at North Georgia College and
13 State University in 1997; and

14 WHEREAS, the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching and the Council for
15 Advancement and Support of Education selected Linda Williams, from a field of 300
16 professors throughout the United States, to receive the 2007 Georgia Professor of the Year
17 Award; and

18 WHEREAS, this award is based on the professor's dedication to undergraduate teaching and
19 is determined by excellence in the professor's impact and involvement with undergraduate
20 students; approach to teaching and learning; contributions to undergraduate education in the
21 institution, community, and profession; and support from colleagues and current and former
22 undergraduate students; and

1 WHEREAS, in recognition of her contributions to the education and welfare of young people
2 in this state, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to honor the extraordinary
3 accomplishments and academic achievements of this outstanding individual.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
5 commend heartily Linda Williams, the 2007 Georgia Professor of the Year, and express to
6 her their sincerest best wishes and confidence in her continued success in the future.
