A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 exemptions from state sales and use tax, so as to extend the sunset of exemption with respect  
3 to the sale or use by a government contractor of overhead materials for an additional period  
4 of time; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from  
8 state sales and use tax, is amended by revising subparagraph (C) of paragraph (58) as  
9 follows:

10 "(C) This paragraph shall stand repealed on January 1, ~~2009~~ 2013;"

11 **SECTION 2.**

12 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
13 without such approval.

14 **SECTION 3.**

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
