- 10 WHEREAS, Louise A. Rice, Ph.D., serves as the national president of Delta Sigma Theta

- 12 WHEREAS, the goals and ideals of Delta Sigma Theta are reflected in its five-point program
- 13 based on economic development, educational development, international awareness and
- 14 involvement, physical and mental health, and political awareness and involvement; and

- 16 including Delta Habitat for Humanity; Project Cherish; Project SMART; The Delta
- 17 Immunization Campaign; School America; Preparing Our Sons for Manhood; the Delta

- 19 Academy; and Summit Five Health and Healing.
