5 families in the City of Carrollton and the West Georgia area until his passing in 2000; and

8 WHEREAS, Almon Funeral Home continues to serve the City of Carrollton and the West
9 Georgia area from its location on Newnan Street; and

10 WHEREAS, it is only fitting that a road be dedicated as a lasting monument to his
11 contributions to the people of this area.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 GEORGIA that the members of this body offer their sincerest condolences to the family and
14 friends of Charles Henry "Chick" Almon on his passing.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the portion of Newnan Street from its intersection with
16 Newnan Road to its intersection with Rome and Bradley Streets, in the City of Carrollton,
17 be dedicated as the Charles Henry "Chick" Almon Memorial Parkway.

19 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the family of Charles Henry
20 "Chick" Almon and to the Department of Transportation.
