A RESOLUTION

4 WHEREAS, Columbus State University's Educational Technology Training Center has
5 nominated Macon County Middle School to present the student projects of Mrs. Julie
6 Greene's class at the 2008 Capitol Tech Day event to be held in the rotunda of the capitol
7 building on February 6, 2008; and

8 WHEREAS, Macon County Middle School is a Georgia Department of Education Title II-D
9 competitive grant recipient; and

10 WHEREAS, Title II-D is a program designed to improve student academic achievement
11 through the effective use of technology in schools, to assist every student in crossing the
12 digital divide by ensuring that every student is technologically literate by the end of eighth
13 grade, and to encourage the effective integration of technology through teacher training and
14 curriculum development to establish successful, research based instructional methods; and

15 WHEREAS, Capitol Tech Day is a collaborative effort between Georgia's schools and the
16 state's Educational Technology Training Centers that features Georgia's students
17 demonstrating the application of 21st century skills to the educational process and the use of
18 fundamental technology tools necessary to succeed in the 21st century; and

19 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of Mrs. Greene's students is a clear indication of
20 the outstanding ability, the dedication and hard work, the unity of purpose and spirit of each
21 of these fine young people, and a tribute to the astute direction and guidance of Mrs. Greene;
