A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 15-12-7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	compensation of court bailiffs and expense allowance for jurors to be fixed by the grand jury
3	and increases, so as to eliminate the maximum per diem allowed to court bailiffs; to eliminate
4	the governing authorities ´ approval of increases in compensation for court bailiffs; to provide
5	for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
7	SECTION 1.
8	Code Section 15-12-7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to compensation
9	of court bailiffs and expense allowance for jurors to be fixed by the grand jury and increases,
10	is amended by striking paragraph (1) of subsection (a) and subsection (b) and inserting in lieu
11	thereof the following:
12	''(1) The compensation of court bailiffs in the superior courts of such counties for the
13	next succeeding year, such compensation not to be less than \$5.00 nor to exceed \$70.00
14	per diem. The same compensation shall be allowed to bailiffs of the several state courts
15	and special courts as is allowed bailiffs in the superior court of the county in which the
16	state or special court is located;"
17	"(b) Any increase in the compensation of court bailiffs or increases in expense allowances
18	for jurors fixed by a grand jury shall be subject to the approval of the governing authority
19	of the county."
20	SECTION 2.
