

House Resolution 1025 (FLOOR SUBSTITUTE)

## A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide for the inclusion of statements  
2 of legislative intent in the general appropriations Act and so as to provide that certain  
3 appropriations must be expended as specifically authorized by the general appropriations  
4 Act; to provide for related matters; to provide for submission of this amendment for  
5 ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

### 7 SECTION 1.

8 Article III of the Constitution is amended by revising subparagraph (e) of Paragraph XIII of  
9 Section V as follows:

10 "(e) The Governor may approve any appropriation together with any corresponding  
11 statement of legislative intent or ~~and~~ veto any other appropriation together with any  
12 corresponding statement of legislative intent in the same bill, and any appropriation  
13 together with any corresponding statement of legislative intent vetoed shall not become law  
14 unless such veto is overridden in the manner herein provided."

### 15 SECTION 2.

16 Said article is further amended by revising Paragraph III of Section IX as follows:

17 "Paragraph III. **General appropriations bill.** (a) The general appropriations bill shall  
18 embrace nothing except appropriations fixed by previous laws; the ordinary expenses of  
19 the executive, legislative, and judicial departments of the government; payment of the  
20 public debt and interest thereon; ~~and for~~ the support of the public institutions and  
21 educational interests of the state; ~~and statements of legislative intent with respect to the~~  
22 purpose and manner of expenditure of appropriated funds. Where a statement of legislative  
23 intent declares that an appropriation is mandatory, that appropriation must be allotted,  
24 approved, and expended for the purpose stated and in the manner stated. The allotment,  
25 approval, and expenditure of other appropriations may be controlled as provided for by  
26 law.
