A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from state sales and use tax, so as to provide for an exemption with respect to 2 3 sales of certain durable medical equipment prescribed by a physician; to repeal conflicting 4 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 6 **SECTION 1.** 7 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from 8 state sales and use tax, is amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows: 9 "(54.2) The sale or use of any durable medical equipment as defined under Titles XVIII 10 and XIX of the federal Social Security Act which is paid for directly by funds of the State 11 of Georgia or the United States under the medicare or Medicaid programs where state or 12 federal law or regulation authorizing such payment prohibits the payment of sales and use 13 tax in connection therewith. The commissioner shall specify by rule or regulation the 14 durable medical equipment eligible for this exemption; prescribed by a physician that is not otherwise exempt under paragraph (54) or (54.1) of this Code section;" 15 16 **SECTION 2.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. 17
