13 actions of young people, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with  
14 particularity the outstanding accomplishments of this individual.

16 commend Cameron John Elward for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest  
17 honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
