A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing congratulations and best wishes to Mr. John Didicher on the occasion of his
2 upcoming 100th birthday; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. John Didicher, beloved husband, father, grandfather, and esteemed citizen
4 of the State of Georgia, celebrates his 100th birthday this April; and

5 WHEREAS, he was born April 28, 1908, in Traunaw, Romania; and

6 WHEREAS, as a child he lived on a farm where they raised corn, wheat, tobacco, hemp, and
7 raised silk worms; and

8 WHEREAS, he apprenticed as a stone mason for three and one-half years before leaving, at
9 the age of 19, to travel to the United States; and

10 WHEREAS, arriving in the United States, he lived with his mother's sister, Aunt Emma
11 Martin, in North Collins, New York, working on their farm for three years; and

12 WHEREAS, he met and was married to the former Christine Rusiska, and they raised two
13 children, Anna Mae and John Edwards; and

14 WHEREAS, he subsequently had five grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren; and

15 WHEREAS, he worked as a civilian during WWII at Venice, Florida Air Force Base where
16 bombers were built; and

17 WHEREAS, he went on to establish his own masonry contracting business, Didicher
18 Construction Company, building masonry projects in Florida, Georgia, and Ohio; and

19 WHEREAS, he built his first house digging the basement by hand using only a shovel; and

1 WHEREAS, when he lost his beloved Christine in 2003, after 71 years of marriage, he
2 moved in with his son John in Marietta, Georgia; and

3 WHEREAS, he currently attends the Lutheran Church of the Resurrection in Marietta, and
4 in his lifetime he has laid the cornerstone in five churches; and

5 WHEREAS, his last stone mason project was a stone fireplace he built for his son which was
6 completed on his 94th birthday, and at the age of 96 he traveled to Appalachia on a mission
7 trip to repair homes.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
9 recognize the abundant and inspirational life of Mr. John Didicher and extend to him their
10 most sincere congratulations and best wishes for his 100th birthday on April 28, 2008.
