A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 general provisions relative to the General Assembly of Georgia, so as to require an oath or  
3 affirmation for purposes of presenting certain testimony to a committee or subcommittee of  
4 the General Assembly; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general  
8 provisions relative to the General Assembly of Georgia, is amended by adding a new Code  
9 section to read as follows:

10 "28-1-18.

11 The sanction of an oath or affirmation equivalent thereto shall be necessary to the  
12 presentation by a person not a member of the General Assembly of any oral evidence in  
13 support or opposition of any legislation or request for appropriation to a committee or  
14 subcommittee of the General Assembly."

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
