## A RESOLUTION

2 Day at the Capitol"; and for other purposes.

4 be champions and serve as outstanding representatives and officers of the young people of  
5 Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Ms. Katie Comer and Mr. Trey Smagur serve with distinction and dedication  
7 as state 4-H president and state 4-H vice president, respectively; and

8 WHEREAS, Dr. Roger C. (Bo) Ryles of Cooperative Extension and state 4-H leader/director  
9 of 4-H has worked diligently with the 4-H Clubs throughout Georgia; and

10 WHEREAS, the leadership, dedication, and hard work of Joshua Akins of Monroe County,  
11 Franklin Duke of Henry County, Chelsea Sawyer of Bleckley County, and Margo Braski of  
12 Houston County as district presidents have been acknowledged by the 4-H membership in  
13 their election of each of these young people to serve as president for 2007-2008; and

14 WHEREAS, the excellent record of accomplishments in citizenship and leadership of April  
15 McDaniel of Burke County, Tareva Moore of Worth County, Austin Suggs of Tift County,  
16 and Laura Warren of Mitchell County were recognized in Washington, D.C., at the 2007

18 WHEREAS, Zach Hall of Lowndes County and Chet Sconyers of Emanuel County were  
19 named 2007 Leadership in Action Winners; and

20 WHEREAS, April Ford of Fayette County, Athena Lao of Clarke County, April McDaniel  
21 of Burke County, Phillip Nowicki of Heard County, and Rico Turner of Emanuel County  
22 were named state winners in the 2007 Dean's Awards competition; and
