A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Garry Curtin; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the preservation and rehabilitation of historic places have contributed to the

3 economic and social well-being of our state by revitalizing downtowns, rehabilitating historic

4 neighborhoods, attracting tourists, increasing tax bases, and creating jobs and real estate

5 investment opportunities in historic districts throughout Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, about three-quarters of a billion private dollars have been invested in

7 completing certified historic rehabilitation projects in Georgia administered by the Historic

8 Preservation Division of the Department of Natural Resources; and

- 9 WHEREAS, historic sites are the number one destination chosen by visitors to Georgia, and
- 10 heritage tourism is a major feature of Georgia's \$28 billion tourism economy that employs
- 11 217,000 Georgians with a return of \$1.3 billion in state and local tax revenue; and

WHEREAS, Columbus State University has become a recognized leader in the historic preservation arena through its many innovative programs and services including its

14 sponsorship of the Preservation Award program; and

WHEREAS, Garry Curtin was recognized at the 41st Annual Meeting and Preservation
Awards program for his outstanding efforts in saving and stabilizing 433 Second Avenue;
and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that he be recognized appropriately for his19 outstanding efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
commend Garry Curtin for the superlative services he has rendered to the State of Georgia
through his inspired efforts on behalf of historic preservation.
