

House Bill 1183

By: Representatives Smith of the 113th, Royal of the 171st, Cox of the 102nd, Lewis of the 15th, and Forster of the 3rd

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act amending Chapter 16 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia
2 Annotated, relating to public property, and amending Part 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title
3 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the university system, approved
4 May 29, 2003 (Ga. L. 2003, p. 313), as amended by an Act approved May 1, 2006 (Ga. L.
5 2006, p. 686), so as to delay the repeal of a certain provision of said Act until June 30, 2010;
6 to amend Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, so as to
7 change certain provisions relating to nonlapsing revenue of institutions in the university
8 system; to change certain provisions relating to nonlapsing of revenue of institutions under
9 the Department of Technical and Adult Education; to provide for automatic repeals of certain
10 provisions; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

12 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

13 (a) An Act amending Chapter 16 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
14 relating to public property, and amending Part 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the
15 Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the university system, approved May 29,
16 2003 (Ga. L. 2003, p. 313), as amended by an Act approved May 1, 2006 (Ga. L. 2006, p.
17 686), is amended by striking Section 6 of said Act and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

18 style="text-align:center">"SECTION 6.

19 Section 1 of this Act shall be repealed in its entirety on June 30, 2005; Sections 2 and 3 of
20 this Act shall be repealed in their entirety on June 30, 2006; and Section 4 of this Act
21 shall be repealed in its entirety on June 30, 2010."

22 (b) The purpose of subsection (a) of this section is to delay the repeal of Section 4 of said
23 Act, which amended subsection (b) of Code Section 50-16-18, relating to writing off small
24 amounts due to the state, until June 30, 2010.

SECTION 2.

1
2 Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, is amended in Part
3 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 3, relating to the university system, by revising Code Section
4 20-3-86, relating to nonlapsing revenue of institutions in the university system, as follows:
5 "20-3-86.
6 Revenue collected by any or all institutions in the university system from tuition,
7 departmental sales or services, continuing education fees, technology fees, or indirect cost
8 recoveries shall not lapse. The amount of revenue from tuition that shall not lapse under
9 this Code section shall not exceed 3 percent of the tuition collected. This Code section
10 shall stand repealed on June 30, ~~2008~~ 2010."

SECTION 3.

11
12 Said title is further amended by revising Code Section 20-4-21.1, relating to nonlapsing
13 revenue of institutions under the Department of Technical and Adult Education, as follows:
14 "20-4-21.1.
15 Revenue collected by any or all institutions under the Department of Technical and Adult
16 Education from departmental sales or services, continuing education fees, technology fees,
17 or indirect cost recoveries shall not lapse. This Code section shall stand repealed on June
18 30, ~~2008~~ 2010."

SECTION 4.

19
20 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
21 without such approval.

SECTION 5.

22
23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
